Teachers should submit two photos; one of their class with the snow sculpture and one with the sculpture only. Any photos submitted by post will not be returned. Submission deadline is February 26th, 2010. Please include the school name, school address, phone number, teachers name and grade level with all entries. One entry per class please. Entries will be judged by staff of The School Milk Foundation of Newfoundland and Labrador.
